Baptism is the sacrament through which we are: (1) reborn as children of God, (2) united with Jesus into His death and Resurrection, (3) cleansed of original sin and personal sins, and (4) welcomed into the Church, the Mystical Body of Christ. 2. Christ Himself, through the minister, baptizes us True and makes us holy with the gifts of the Holy Spirit and impresses on our souls a character or mark that cannot be taken away. 3. Jesus promised to remain with us, through the Holy Spirit the new Christian is united so **Baptism** 4.Through closely with Jesus that he shares in Christ's death and Resurrection. 5.During the rite of Baptism, the minister immerses True the person to be baptized in water or pours water on his head while saying, "I baptize you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." The water is a sign of life and of cleansing. 6. Since the earliest times, Baptism has been True administered to children, for it is a grace and a gift of God that does not presuppose any human merit; children are baptized in the faith of the Church. Entry into Christian life gives access to true freedom. 7. The Church has been given the sacraments, which True Christ instituted, as the special means of continuing Christ's work on earth. 8. The Sacrament of Baptism permanently relates us True to God as His adopted children, and joins us to Christ's priesthood and His prophetic and kingly mission. is a sacrament that confirms or Confirmation strengthens the life of the Spirit which was given to us at Baptism. In virtue of this sacrament, the faithful are obliged to spread and defend the Faith as true witnesses of Christ. 10. Confirmation, which seals a candidate with the Eucharist Spirit, is linked with the other sacraments of Christian initiation--Baptism and 11.
